Wedding Ringing at Grundisburgh, Burgh and Hasketon.

The ringers will provide bells for your wedding wherever possible. At Burgh and Hasketon, there are only 6 bells, which is the minimum for a joyful sound. Grundisburgh has 12 bells, so there are more options, but generally people opt for 6 bells to keep the cost down.

The fee is £25.00 per bell. Thus 6 bells will cost £150.00 (All 12 bells at Grundisburgh would be £300.00, 10 bells £250.00, 8 bells £200.00).

Please supply the location, date and time of your wedding and a telephone number.

Normally we ring for a few minutes before the Wedding Service and immediately afterwards for about 10 minutes. If you have any special requests or have other things happening which might conflict with the bells - e.g. a piper playing you out of the church - please include that in the email.

We aim to help you make your wedding as enjoyable as possible. Emailing ensures that it does not get overlooked!

You are very welcome to visit us in the ringing chamber at Grundisburgh on Sunday mornings. We ring from 10.15 to 11.00 most weeks. Occasionally, there is not a Service or we cannot get enough ringers, so it is probably best to check with Stephen.
